## **SWSC to Conduct First District-Wide eLearning Days**

**SULLIVAN, IN-** The Southwest School Corporation will conduct its first district-wide eLearning days Friday, February 16 and Monday, February 19, 2018. These eLearning days will serve as required make-up days for the weather-related district closings that occurred January 12 and 15, 2018.

eLearning is an innovative way to provide a seamless educational experience for students through the use of technology. According to SWSC Superintendent Chris Stitzle, “Offering an excellent educational experience to our students is a top priority. eLearning is a way for SWSC to continue to provide high-quality educational opportunities to our students outside of the traditional classroom.”

During the scheduled eLearning days, students will access assignments off-campus through the district’s learning management system, Canvas. Teacher and technical assistance will be available to students during designated office hours. The school buildings will be closed to students.

Originally scheduled as winter break, February 16 and 19 were chosen for eLearning make-up days in order for the district to evaluate the viability of eLearning days for future implementation.

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
