SELF-SCREENING for COVID-19 Symptoms

Beginning August 11, 2020, the Southwest School Corporation (SWSC) will require all parents/guardians to self-screen their child(ren) for symptoms of COVID-19 **each morning before school.**

Symptoms Impacting Consideration for Exclusion from School:

- A fever of 100.4 degrees or greater
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

Students should be excluded from school if they test positive for COVID-19 or exhibit one or more of the symptoms of COVID-19 based on CDC Guidance that is not otherwise explained.

Students sent to school exhibiting the above-symptoms will be sent home immediately.

Communication between parents/guardians and the School Nurse is essential. Upon enrolling or re-enrolling your child(ren) for school, please update all contacts and phone numbers on Harmony.
